

DISCIPLES OF THEWORD LAY ADVISOR SERVICE AGREEMENT

Disciples of the Word is a mentoring and coaching experience for permanent deacons and priests seeking to improve their craft.

Each cohort will consist of a Preaching Fellow, a Clergy Mentor and three Lay Advisors.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE LAY ADVISOR

- 1. Advisors are required to attend three in-person events at the seminary:
 - o January 25, 2025- programlaunch
 - o June 28, 2025- mid-program review
 - o November 22, 2025 conclusion
- 2. Advisors are required to meet monthly with their cohorts, from February through November 2025; meeting times and places are set at the convenience of the cohort.
- Advisors will use CPI provided guidelines and rubrics to review a Fellow's videotaped homilies, providing constructive feedback at their monthly cohort meetings; feedback will share preaching best practices, spiritual insights and theological acumen.
- 4. Advisors must provide a completed IRS form W-9 to receive stipend payments.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CATHOLIC PREACHING INSTITUTE

- 1. CPI will host three in-person events at the seminary:
 - o January 25, 2025- program launch
 - o June 28, 2025 mid-program review
 - o November 22, 2025 conclusion

- 2. CPI will provide cohorts with access to Fellows' uploaded homilies within one week of recording.
- 3. CPI will provide cohorts with instructions and a homily review rubric to be used for the review of videotapedhomilies.
- 4. CPI will provide forms for requesting travel reimbursement (see below).

COMPENSATION PLAN

- 1. Advisors will receive a \$2,000 stipend at the conclusion of the 10-month program.
- 2. Advisors are reimbursed for travel expenses (tolls and fuel at the IRS standard reimbursement rate) related to cohort meetings (monthly) and program meetings (at the Seminary).
- 3. Payments will be made in paper checkform only and mailed to the address indicated on the IRS form W-9.
